



To Our Valued Guests;

In light of the recent situation with COVID-19, we would like to update you on how we are managing the situation at Darrell's. On March 15<sup>th</sup> as per the Province of NS requirements, we have reduced seating to safe distances within our dining rooms, reducing our seating from 80 to 44. We continue to monitor the assessments and recommendations of the Province of NS, <https://novascotia.ca/coronavirus/#alerts> and Provincial Health <http://www.nshealth.ca/covid19-news> and will adhere to their advice and guidelines pertaining to these recommendations.

- On top of normal, day-to-day practices, we've implemented an additional and thorough regime of continually cleaning and sanitizing all surfaces, railings, door handles, debit machines and all other surfaces that are considered shared contact or otherwise.
- We've removed all condiments from table-tops and will be offered in individual packaging when requested by our guests.
- All staff have been advised that travel to any location posing a greater threat will result in a mandatory 14-day self-isolation and will not be permitted to return to work until that period has passed and they show no signs of illness. This includes common colds.

We at Darrell's take health and food safety very seriously at the best of times, following all public health requirements and guidelines. There is nothing more important to us than the well-being of our guests, staff and community. Since the outbreak of COVID-19, we have taken additional steps for the safety of our clients and staff.
